**TRAINING** – a training plan is needed; ensure adequate training materials are available to the users; ensure proper scheduling so that all users are properly trained. Determine resources for users post training – help desk; documentation; help files within the software.

**DOCUMENTATION** – requirements for documentation – public company vs privately held. Create an organized, accessible central repository.

And, of course, Go Live and Beyond – where help desk and continued training are critical to the ongoing success of the upgrade.

## WATERMELON

Level: Easy Total Prep: 20 Minutes

#### Ingredients:

- 17-8 lb. seedless watermelon
- 1/2 cup extra virgin olive oil
- · 3 limes, juiced
- 11/2 tsp salt

- · 3/4 tsp black pepper
- · 1 cup fresh chopped mint leaves
- 11/2 cups crumbled feta cheese (goat or sheep's milk feta is best)

#### Directions:

Cut the rind from the watermelon then chop the watermelon into 1" chunks. Place chunks in a colander to drain. In a small bowl, whisk together olive oil, fresh lime juice, salt, and black pepper to create a dressing. Place chunks of watermelon in a large salad bowl. Pour dressing and chopped mint over the watermelon and toss to coat. Crumble the feta into the salad bowl and mix gently to integrate the cheese into the salad. Serve chilled.
